## **OVERVIEW**

## SCORE REPORTING

<u>Description of Your Submission Performance.</u> Your Series FLEX submission is reviewed by two independent scorers. Scorers judge the overall effectiveness of each submission using a performance score scale and a set of performance characteristics. <u>Retaking the Test.</u> Candidates who wish to retake Series FLEX must wait until they receive their scores before they are able to register for a retake of the same Series FLEX. In all cases, when Series FLEX is submitted as a retake, the entire submission is scored without reference to the previous submission.
